WELFARE CONSTITUTION

Income

Income sources shall be:

- 1. Monthly membership and welfare dues from members (GHC25)
- 2. Donations received from members, groups, other individuals, and organizations.
- 3. Proceeds from special fundraising activities.
- 4. Any other source, as the executive board may determine from time to time.

To ensure the efficient collection of monies, the treasurer shall be tasked with collecting monies from members.

Benefits

The following life-changing events of members shall necessitate disbursements from the welfare fund.

1. Childbirth

- A sum of GHC1,000 shall be presented to the family at the naming or dedication ceremony. A member shall benefit from childbirth disbursements once.

2. Wedding

- A sum of GHC1,000 shall be presented to a member getting married. A member shall benefit from wedding disbursement once.

3. Bereavement

- A sum of GHC 1,000 shall be presented to a member on the death of either parent.
- A sum of GHC 2,000 shall be presented to a member on the death of his spouse.
- On the death of a member, a sum of GHC 2,000 shall be presented to the family of the deceased.

4. Sickness

- An amount of GHC 2,000 shall be presented to a member who is sick terminally or is hospitalized and unable to work for 6 months

Lapsation

A member who defaults payment for **more than 3 months** will not receive the total amount due. Instead, the executive board in consultation with the entire group, will on their discretion determine how much should be given.

In all of these suggestions, a member shall benefit only after paying their membership and welfare dues for at least 6 months.
